Release Note

The content of this release note relates to new features, enhancements and bug fixes in ICEFLO for Mobile (M) and Enterprise (E) editions. These are defined in the tables below:

New Features

The following table defines the features which have been introduced as part of this release:

1.	Board View of Tasks	We've introduced the Board View of Tasks which will complement the Construction process of Runbooks. This new feature also introduces the first instance of drag and drop. See What's New for further information.		✓
2.	Issues Menu Link	We've introduced a new Issues domain on the Menu link, which will display a list of Issues which are of specific interest or have been aligned to you. See What's New for further information.		✓
3.	Issue across the Lifecycle of a Runbook	Issues can now be raised across the full lifecycle of a Runbook, which means any Runbook state.		✓
4.	Issues for Tasks	A new Issues tab has been added to the Task detail screen which can be used to align NO Action Issues to specific Tasks, along with enabling a range of other relevant general Issues actions, including Suspend Task. See What's New for further information.		✓
5.	Task Issues Visualisations	A new column has been added to the Primary Report for List Tasks on Runbooks and Events, which displays a visualisation showing the count and severity of Issues related to a Task. See What's New for further information.		✓
6.	Event Issues	Issues can now be created and managed from the Event Issues domain. See What's New for further information.		✓
7.	Managing Issues	An Issue can now be Raised and Closed in one action. See What's New for further information.		✓
8.	Panel Expansions	A range of panels across ICEFLO now have an expandable icon which enables the panel to be		✓



		expanded to full page. See What's New for further information.		
9.	Edit Task	Modification has been made for launching the Edit Task Screen 408 from an embedded screen to a modal pop up.		✓
10.	Dependencies	Implicit Dependencies have been removed from the solution and all dependencies to be explicit whether requested via Link or Add Predecessor function.		✓
11.	Ideas Portal	We've introduced an Ideas portal which can be accessed in ICEFLO and used to offer ideas for New Features and Enhancements. See What's New for more information.		✓

Enhancements

The following table defines the features which have been enhanced as part of this release:

1.	External Dependencies	The format for selection of an External Dependency has been changed and navigation back to the Task Detail screen has been added.		✓
2.	Issues	A Runbook can be Suspended, Abandoned or Backed Out from the Task Issues tab.		✓
3.	Edit Issue	Modification has been made on launching of the Edit Issue Screen 604 from an embedded screen to modal pop up.		✓
4.	Search and Replace	All Search and Replace changes will now be reflected in the Activity Panel of a Runbook.		✓
5.	Additional checkboxes on Add Task	The Notify Me and Milestone checkboxes have been added as options to select when you click Add Task from the List Task screen.		✓
6.	Create User Wizard	A field has been added to show which timezone is associated with a Location, a mandatory field in the Create User Wizard.		✓
7.	Issue Estimated Resolution Time	When adding an Estimated Resolution Time to an Issue, the Time or Duration can now be selected.		✓
8.	Dependency Navigation	Adding or removing Dependencies, using the next or previous arrows will now retain the preceding Runbook in question.		✓



Bug Fixes

The following table defines the bugs which have been fixed as part of this release:

ID	Title	Description	M	E
1.	Search & Replace	When doing a search and replace and replacing with with null data, the title became blank and it was not possible to revert the title to the original. This has been rectified with an error message: Please confirm you want to replace 'Governance' with 'NULL/BLANK' for the selected tasks		✓
2.	Search & Replace	When doing a Search and Replace on a title which exceeds the character limit, there was no validation. This has been rectified.		✓
3.	Delete Task	Deleting a Task disabled the Next and Previous arrows. This has now been re-enabled.		✓
4.	Comms on Checkpoint Tasks	It is now possible to add Comms to a Checkpoint Task from the Edit Tasks screen.		✓
5.	Custom Reports	On occasion, adding and removing multiple columns to create a custom view was not retaining all the required changes on selection. This has now been fixed.		✓
6.	Duplicate Runbooks	Double clicking on Create Runbook will no longer create duplicate Runbooks.		✓
7.	Event Runbooks	Double click on an Event STP button will no longer present an error.		✓
8.	Data Dictionary on User Defined Fields	When User Defined Fields have been changed using the Data Dictionary, the new names will show in the Activity Panel, when the User Defined Fields are being referenced.		✓
9.	Stage Status Report	The redundant checkbox column has been removed from Report 17 on Event List Tasks – Stage Status Report.		✓
10.	Delete Users	Users with Manager authorisation can now only delete and de-activate Users with Authorisation level of Manager or below.		✓
11.	Issue Raised on Add Task	An Issue will no longer be raised if a Task is added Post Commit.		✓
12.	Task Detail from Home Screen	There is no longer an error in trying to view a Task's Detail from My Tasks on the Home Page.		✓
13.	Pre Imp Predecessors	Imp Tasks will no longer present when adding Predecessors to a Pre Imp Task.		✓
14.	Stage Headers	User Defined Fields can now have detail added on Stage Headers.		✓



15.	Duplicate Dependencies	On some very specific occasions, Duplicate Dependencies were being created. This issue is now resolved.		✓
