New Features

1.	Ability to Enable/Disable the Upload Documents Feature	We are now able to disable or enable the Upload Documents feature for specific Clients.		Y
2.	Record of all Stage & Task Creation and Edits	A new Activity panel in the STP – Detail screen, 114, records all edits and updates to Stages & Tasks from Edit Task and Grid Edit (404 and 408). This compliments the simplification of the authorisation privileges, as described below.		Y

3.	Technical Detail can be Entered when Adding a Stage	The Technical Detail field has been enabled on the Add Stage pop up, so you can enter this information on creation of the Stage.		Y
4.	Enhanced Import Template	An enhanced Import Template has been uploaded to ICEFLO which supports the correct use of the Import structure and cell formatting and has more information provided as a guide.		Y
5.	Closed and Abandoned STPs Removed from Home Page STPs	On the Home Page the Abandoned and Closed STPs have been removed from the STPs panel.		Y

1.	Automatic Refresh on Edit mode of STP – Stage not appearing in Edit on Add Stage	Adding a Stage on edit mode of STP – Tasks (formerly screen 410, now 404) didn't automatically refresh and caused confusion. This has now been resolved and your newly added Stage will show.		Y
2.	'Incidents' Mentioned Instead of 'Issues'	Incidents were mentioned on the Documents section of screens 604, Maintain Issue and 114, STP – Detail. This has been rectified.		Y
3.	Schedule and STP - Gauge Mismatch	Due to Spring Clock Change the STP – Gauge and the STP – Schedule were inconsistent.		Y
4.	Validation Errors Unable to Download on Import	The option to download the errors from screen 481, Validation Errors can now be downloaded successfully.		Y



5.	Potential Predecessors Displaying Incorrect End Times	The end time on the Potential Predecessors' dependencies list was mapping to the start time of the Task, regardless of Task duration. This mapping has been corrected and the times now show as expected.		Y
6.	Filter on Task Sequence and Stage Sequence	On screen 400, STP – Tasks the filter on Task and Stage Sequence on the Primary Report was not returning the correct data.		Y
7.	Search on Task ID	At STP level using the search bar Task ID's were not presenting the correct results.		Y
8.	Event Task Download Corrupt	User Defined fields containing < or > corrupted the download of Event Tasks. This has been resolved.		Y
9.	Technical Detail Report Failing	On STP – Tasks the Technical Detail report was failing if the Description field had over 2000 characters. This has been resolved and the report opens successfully.		Y
